Activity Description:

Step-by-Step Instructions:



1) Prepare:

Make sure the rolls are clean and dry.

2) Paint:

Paint your rolls with camouflage colors. Let them dry.



3) Connect:

Glue the two rolls side by side. Add a strip of paper around the middle for extra hold.

4) Add String:

Poke a hole on each side and thread the string through. Tie knots on the ends.



5) Explore:

Use your binoculars to explore nature to see amazing things!
